

Includes (1) 2hp High Output Blower(C.F.M.:900, Pressure: 9.5"), Enclosed Slide Loft , Safety Screens on Sides and Top of Slide, Removable Climbing Surface Cover, (3) Deflation Zipper, Reinforcement Strips on all Mattress Seams, Tethers, Stakes (Min. 5/8" Diameter on stakes) varies see diagram inside, Repair Kit. Recommended Load: Varies, See rules attached to to each unit.

### Directions

- · Read "Installation and Setup Manual" completely.
- · Layout ground tarp for inflatable (not provided)
- · Remove unit from storage bag.
- Position inflatable on tarp with a level ground area approximately 30' x 20'. Unit should have 18' of clearance on all sides with 20' height clearance.
- Close off and secure any remaining auxiliary air tube(s).
- · Close zipper & water/air flaps on unit.
- Connect blower to slide air tube making sure strap is firmly secure.
- · Blower requires a dedicated 20 amp breaker.
- Turn blower on and steer the slide up with the top guide tether on rear wall of slide.
- Secure all remaining bottom tethers firmly to 18" stakes after the unit is fully inflated. Bury stakes flush with ground.
- Install 36" ground stake to the recommended depth and secure top slide tether from rear of slide to the 36" stake.
- Do a safety check on blower and electric Cord. If electric cord gets damaged, Replace immediately.
- Electric Cords must be UL Listed for Outdoor Use. Max Length 50' 14-3
- Do a safety check of slide and climb covers.
- Do a safety check on the interior and exterior surfaces of units looking for any moisture, debris, rips, tears or seams coming apart. (If noticed, do not use inflatable until repaired)


### Method for securing 18" and 36" Anchor Stakes:

- · After the unit is fully inflated on firm ground, such as grassed area.
- Secure all bottom tethers to 18" x 1/2" stakes (Bury Flush)
- Secure all top tethers to 36" stakes (Bury 75%)
- · Do not operate in winds over 15 m.p.h.






#### WATER SYSTEM

THE SYSTEM IS PRE-INSTALLED AT THE FACTORY, AND IS READY TO BE USED.





### THE CORRECT POSITIONING FOR BOUNCING!

- Do not allow riders to pull or hang or mesh.
- Do not allow riders to bounce agains the sides or near the entrance.
- Have riders stay away from others so they don't get hurt from bumping into each other.

Warning: Injuries will occur if you do not follow these rules.



Step by step Procedures for *Obstacle Bounce Combo* 


 Enter the unit by crawling through the front door entrance flap.



With arms crossed over your chest, slide down feet first only.




2. Start bouncing in the bouncer.



(For Pool Only)

5. Have rider exit the pool as soon as they get to the bottom to avoid others sliding into them.
Assist participants out of the pool!



Climb up the stairs by leaning forward and grabbing bars to direct you to the top of the slide.



(For Landing Only)
6. Have riders slide to

bottom of landing and immediately get up and exit the ride.
Assist participants out of the landing!

AVOID INJURIES! DO NOT enter the slide lane head first!


 Be sure to sit down at the top of the slide with your feet out in front of you, then push off going feet first only.



 Operators should not allow participants to slide down until slide landing area is clear of riders.

## DO NOT OVERLOAD THE BOUNCER OR SLIDE!


 Do not put to many participants in the bouncer or slide at one time. Do not allow more than 2 kids on slide unit at a time.
 Only let one participant slide at a time.



Operators must take control!

CAUTION: Do not allow more than 2 riders on slide unit at a time.






• Be sure to instruct all operators of the correct procedures to have passengers follow as they ride the inflatable.





Warning: All riders should stay at least 3 feet away from other participants to avoid injury!




Pool Unit Only!

 Warning: Fill pool to water line before using slide.

• Warning: Water level must be maintained at 14" at all times for safe operation.




### Catastrophe!

This type of catastrophe can always be avoided by proper tethering utilizing the ground stakes provided and by having Trained Operator(s) on duty and avoiding inclement weather such as high winds i.e. winds in excess of 15 m.p.h.

### Procedures for evacuation!

Each blower tube has an automatic air flap that reduces the loss of air if the blower system goes off, however, all participants should be directed off the inflatable as shown by the arrow(s) below. In the event of a power outage or in an emergency take down, the participants should be directed to exit the slide and bouncer ASAP!
